Submission Guidelines

- All work submitted to our journal must be **written entirely by undergraduates**. Acceptable examples of this include research papers, conference papers, literature reviews, independent studies, senior theses, and other anthropological writing samples.
- Similarly, the work must represent research of an anthropological nature or be related to advancements in anthropological thought. Submissions relating to fields of study other than anthropology and its subfields will not be considered for upload.
- All submissions must contain an abstract briefly overviewing their paper's main points, research methods, goals, and other important information. This abstract will be used in the contents section of each journal publication.
- Your submission may utilize whatever citation style you feel most comfortable using. Your submission must, however, contain both in-text references in the form of parenthetical citations or footnotes, and must also contain a complete references cited list, alphabetized by first author's last name.
- All submissions must have a header, including the title of the paper, subtitle (if applicable), and, beneath these, authors listed in order.
- All submissions must be submitted in Times New Roman, 12-point font, and single spaced. Illustrations, graphs, and figures may be included in-text, and must be cited as such with proper attribution where necessary.
- We encourage a page limit of 15 pages maximum, with minimal exceptions. This includes your cited references.
